



Infilling of the Lundby harbor basin and relocation of the Kville canal in Gothenburg



Invitation to a public consultation prior to the application for a permit under the Environmental Code

Älvstranden Utveckling AB, Göteborgs Frihamns AB and Fastighets AB Fribordet (the Applicants) intend to apply for a permit under the Environmental Code for measures aimed at, among other things, implementing parts of the City's plans to transform Frihamnen and Lindholmen in Gothenburg. The application is mainly intended to cover:

- Demolition of the quay.
- Infilling of the Lundby harbor basin (Lundbyhamnen).
- Relocation of the Kville canal (Kvillekanalen, excavation, etc.).
- Construction of supporting structures, piling, pile concrete slab and sheet piling at Keillers kaj (quay).

The infilling of the Lundby harbor basin aims to connect Lindholmen and Frihamnen by creating new land in central Gothenburg that in the long term can be used both for buildings and as public areas, such as parks.

Before preparing an application for the permit, the Applicants must consult individuals such as those who are likely to be particularly concerned by the planned measures. The Applicants have assessed that property owners, line and pipe owners and leaseholders (such as tenants and tenant owners) within the defined area of influence for noise emissions during the construction phase, see map on the next page, are to be considered as individuals who are likely to be particularly affected. The Applicants have drawn up a consultation document containing information on, among other things, the design and scope of the planned measures, the environmental effects the measures may cause, and the preliminary content of the environmental impact statement. Following the consultation, the Applicants will proceed with the permit application. The application is planned to be submitted to the Land and Environmental Court at

Vänersborg District Court in the autumn of 2022. The measures are scheduled to start in 2024 at the earliest.

Individuals likely to be particularly affected by the planned measures are hereby invited to submit their comments.

The consultation document is available until 29 June 2022 in Älvrummet Lindholmspiren 3–5, Gothenburg or at alvstranden.com/lundbyhamnen.
